You are created in the image and likeness of God

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. (Genesis 1:27)

You are fearfully and wonderfully made

I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. (Psalm 139:14)

You are more than a conqueror

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (Romans 8:37)

You are no longer a slave to sin

We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. (Romans 6:6)

You are a child of God

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, (John 1:12)

See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are. (1 John 3:1)

You are not condemned

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)

You can never be separated from God's love

For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

You are chosen to bear fruit that lasts

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. (John 15:16)

You, with other believers, form one body

...so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. (Romans 12:5)

You are one with Christ

But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. (1 Corinthians 6:17)

You are chosen, holy, royal; a special possession of God

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Peter 2:9)

You have wisdom from God

And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, (1 Corinthians 1:30)

Your labor is not in vain

Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. (1 Corinthians 15:58)

You are a new creation

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. (2 Corinthians 5:17)

You are a friend of God

No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. (John 15:15)

You are an adopted child of God

he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, (Ephesians 1:5)

You are God's child

for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. (Galatians 3:26)

You have every spiritual blessing

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, (Ephesians 1:3)

You are redeemed and forgiven of all of your sins

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, (Ephesians 1:7)

You are clothed and one in Christ

For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. (Galatians 3:27-28)

You have Christ living in you

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20)

You are chosen

In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, (Ephesians 1:11)

You are for the praise of his glory

so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. (Ephesians 1:12)

You have been seated in the heavenly realms

and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, (Ephesians 2:6)

You've been given the incomparable riches of God's grace

so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:7)

You are God's handiwork; you are created for good works

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)

You, who were once far away, have been brought near

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. (Ephesians 2:13)

You are built together as a holy building

In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit. (Ephesians 2:22)

You are a Temple

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

You may approach God with freedom and confidence

in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. (Ephesians 3:12)

You are light

for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light (Ephesians 5:8)

Your citizenship is in Heaven

But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, (Philippians 3:20)

You have been given power, love, and self-control

for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control. (2 Timothy 1:7)

Your joy overflows

so that in me you may have ample cause to glory in Christ Jesus, because of my coming to you again. (Philippians 1:26)

All your needs are met according to his glorious riches

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

You are holy and faithful

To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father. (Colossians 1:2)

You are held together by God

And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. (Colossians 1:17)

You have hope of glory

To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. (Colossians 1:27)

You will become fully mature

Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. (Colossians 1:28)

You have hidden treasures of wisdom and knowledge

in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (Colossians 2:3)

You are rooted and built up

rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. (Colossians 2:7)

You have been given the fullness of the deity

For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority. (Colossians 2:9-10)

You are raised with Christ

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. (Colossians 3:1-4)

You will rise from the dead

For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. (1 Thessalonians 4:16)
